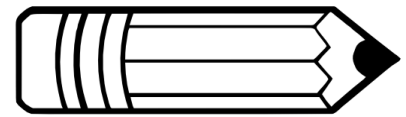



# second grade supply list 2023-2024

<b>Second Grade Supplies</b>	<b><u>OPTIONAL ADDITIONAL</u> Second Grade Supplies</b>
<p><b>-The following items are for classroom use and will be shared among the students in our class. Please <u>DO NOT</u> label these items.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 8 <b>BLACK</b> EXPO markers with caps (NO push-up EXPO markers, please.)</li><li>• 4 big glue sticks</li><li>• 2 boxes of regular #2 pencils, <b>sharpened</b> (Dixon Ticonderoga, if possible)</li><li>• 2 packs of big pink erasers (2 per pack)</li><li>• 2 boxes of tissues</li><li>• 1 container of Clorox wipes</li><li>• 1 box of plastic sandwich bags (<b>BOYS BRING</b>)</li><li>• 1 box of plastic gallon sized bags (<b>GIRLS BRING</b>)</li></ul> <p><b>-The following items are for personal use. Please label each item with your child's name.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 1 plastic two-pocket homework folder (Students need a plastic folder because it lasts longer and will most likely last the entire school year.)</li><li>• 2 boxes of crayons (no more than a box of 24)</li><li>• 1 pack of markers (8-10 pack)</li><li>• 1 plastic pencil box (regular size 8.5 x 5 inches)</li><li>• 1 pair of scissors</li><li>• 1 pair of headphones (Please bring to school in a plastic gallon sized bag with your child's first and last name on it.)</li></ul>	<p>-The following items are <b>OPTIONAL</b> supplies that students may want to have in order to help them stay organized and to complete daily activities and assignments.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Computer mouse for Chromebook</b> (Students need to record math and reading test answers on their Chromebook. Having a computer mouse will allow them to record and submit their work easier than using the mouse pad on the Chromebook.)</li><li>• <b>Zippered Pouch</b> (As the school year progresses, the crayon boxes and marker boxes break. Students may want to use a zippered pouch in order to keep their crayons and markers more organized and to prevent losing them. Students will still need a plastic pencil box for their pencils, erasers, EXPO markers, and scissors.
